**Grant Project:** Repair of the No Discharge Buoy and purchase of oil absorbent booms - \$2,200

Dear Dr. Berounsky:

We are pleased to present our final report on our 2015 grant project.

The No Discharge Buoy has been refurbished by being striped of old signs and markings off the buoy and cleaned it. They then reinstalled new signs and Coast Guard required stripping. The no discharge informational buoy has been placed at the entrance of the Kickemuit River by the Bristol Harbormaster. The Bristol Harbormaster has agreed to remove and store the buoy during the winter and reinstall the buoy each spring. Please see attached photos of the buoy.

The Oil Absorbent Booms have turned over the Warren and Bristol Harbormasters. See attached photo. A letter has been sent to the Bristol Town Council and Town Administrator, the Warren Town Council and Town Manager advising them of the donation of the Oil Booms from the Kickemuit River Council made possible by a grant from the RIRC and RIWRB.

I also plan on contacting the local newspaper to do an article about the grant. After the busy 4<sup>th</sup> of July period is over.
